Fakenham Angling Club – Complaints Procedure

Purpose: This procedure ensures all complaints are handled fairly, promptly, and consistently, while giving members and visitors confidence that their concerns will be taken seriously.

1. Submitting a Complaint

- All complaints must be submitted in writing to the Club Secretary.
- Accepted formats:
- Email: georgetwite@btinternet.com
- Letter
- No verbal, text message, social media, or other forms of complaint will be accepted.

2. Information to Include

To help us investigate effectively, please include:

- 1. Your name and contact details
- 2. Date of the incident or issue
- 3. Full details of your concern (including names of any people involved, if known)
- 4. Any supporting evidence (photos, correspondence, witness statements)

3. Acknowledgement of Complaint

- The Club Secretary will acknowledge receipt of your complaint within 7 calendar days of receiving it.
- If additional information is required, you will be contacted.

4. Investigation Process

- The Club Secretary will review the details and may consult relevant parties.
- If the matter concerns the Club Secretary directly, another committee member will be appointed to handle it.
- Investigations will be carried out impartially, confidentially, and in line with the club's Disciplinary and Hearing Procedure.

5. Outcome

- A written response will be sent to you within 28 calendar days of acknowledgement, outlining:
- The findings of the investigation
- Any actions to be taken by the club
- Any recommendations for resolution

6. Appeal

- If you are dissatisfied with the outcome, you may request an appeal in writing within 14 days of the decision.
- Appeals will be reviewed by the Club Chairperson and two committee members not previously involved in the matter.
- The appeal decision will be final.

7. Confidentiality

• All complaints will be treated in confidence, and details will only be shared with those directly involved in resolving the matter.
